## Initiatives Undertaken by Junior Club

- Improved facilities – upgraded all nets over the past couple of years
- Invested in district program fostering development of approx 100 juniors
- Strengthened committee which has now approx 20 members with each member having roles and responsibilities
- Engaging more parents to be involved in the club by committee delegating more responsibilities to Aged Coordinators who in turn will delegate more responsibilities to teams
- Funded level 1 coaching programs for all coaches
- Developed community cricket clinics over the past 2 years
- More effort into getting sponsors and committee made decision to provide free shirts this season
- Planning to run an internal T20 comp for our teams this season
- Support our Association and also WACA committees by having representatives on these committees



## Initiatives In Progress

- Develop more effective one club relationship with senior club
- Improve support for our Coaches
- Develop a Coaches Handbook
- Issue a periodic newsletter
- Ensure our in2cricket and T20 programs are more effective and increase participation to support community cricket
- Cricket Australia looking at making wholesale change to community cricket rules which are being piloted over east this season



# Community Cricket

- Part of Central Association (previously BMML)
- Governed by CJCC
- U10's through to U17's
- Over 20 clubs in our Association
- Focus is on player participation, having fun and enjoyment
- **ALL PLAYERS** must get an equal go – it's not about winning!



# Registration & Team Allocation Process

- Online registration Process
- Numerous registration errors such as grades, days and competitions and late registrations
- Team Allocation process
  - Clear policy on our website
  - Try to accommodate requests
  - Need to balance keeping teams together from previous years, not excluding players, eliminating “super” teams, having appropriate team numbers and mixing with our community
  - Some coaches extend invitations for certain players to join their teams. This will just lead to unmet expectations.
  - Teams are “owned” by the club not the coach. Coaches are invited by the club to coach a team.

# Spirit of The Game

- No Sledging – Sledging is “anything negative said on a field which a player hears”. Club and Association will suspend players for sledging.
- Disputes with Opposition
- Benefit of doubt rests with batsman, lbw, catches, run outs , stumpings etc etc
- Suspensions
  - Players (community and district)
  - Coaches – poor behaviour, ignoring club rules/directions, playing unregistered players
